Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station Maintains Normal Operation

The outbreak of an earthquake of magnitude 8.9 occurred in North-eastern Japan on 11th March triggered a severe tsunami. Following the earthquake, the seismic detectors at the Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station (Daya Bay) recorded normal. The earthquake and the subsequent tsunami did not affect the normal operation of the power station.

The site of Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station was carefully selected according to international guidelines and approved by the National Nuclear Safety Administration based on its stringent safety assessment. The nearby area is seismically stable and the probability for a massive earthquake affecting the site is very low.

Daya Bay has comprehensive safety systems, robust standby backup systems and emergency arrangements. The safety facilities are tested on a regular basis in accordance to the stringent requirements of the state regulations so as to ensure it operates safely with no adverse impact to the environment.

HKNIC is a wholly owned subsidiary of CLP Holdings Ltd. founded in 1983. It is an investor in the Guangdong Nuclear Power Joint Venture Company Ltd., which owns the Guangdong Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station located in China's Guangdong Province. Daya Bay supplies 70% of its annual output to meet about 25% of the power demand in Hong Kong, contributing to CLP's excellent power services with high supply reliability, outstanding environmental performance and affordable tariffs.
